**I**nstant imp—that's you—and it takes no more primping than a quick wish with a brush to style this tousled toss. Front and center, a fringe of fluffy bangs; the sides are basically turned under; here and there a curl unfurls. Round in back, it's tapered to shape. Permanently waved Dynel modacrylic is on a stretch cap of nylon that fits every head. Twenty-eight shades, including frosted; ready to carry away in its own case. The Faun, by David & David; about \$25

**F**lip your wig (gently, of course) and have a beguiling new style

each time you play put-on (quite a clever cover for short cuts or hair that's twist-and-tween the length you long for). Here it is, a fourteen-inch midi-wig with



a full quota of bangs that's as changeable as the time of day. Flip it as we did here, scoop it into a ponytail or tuck it into a soft, pretty pageboy. Kanekalon modacrylic stays in place, all shined and sleek, and rests on a comfortable stretch base. Sixteen shades, including frosted. Pretty Kitty by Cindy Carver; about \$26



**P**in-ons play a part in your holiday headlines, but they're not the whole show. The shaded sections of hair here are the pin-ons, the rest is what you've grown yourself.

**A switch in time** can take you back to Gibson Girl days. Just bun a two-foot hank of "hair" into a coil for the topnote. Brush your own front hair down and ponytail the rest at the crown. Anchor a two-inch-wide piece of cotton batting around your head (like a headband), brush hair back over the cotton and secure; then fasten the bun over the ponytail. The switch of custom-blended Dynel can also become a chignon, a braid or a ponytail; about \$19. To pin on and on:

tiny prefab **tendrils** at each ear and along the nape of the neck; each about \$3.50. All by Tovar Tresses.

**Take a free fall** and glide through the holiday rush unruffled. This flipped one has built-in height and thickness; a clean sweep of your own hair will cover the pin-on spot. Nature Blend, of Modac 53; twenty-four shades. Helene Curtis; about \$18.

**More little extras:** a "George" peruke on its own barrette; skinny wrappy braids; plump peasant plaits
