

HAIIRDOS OF THE MONTH

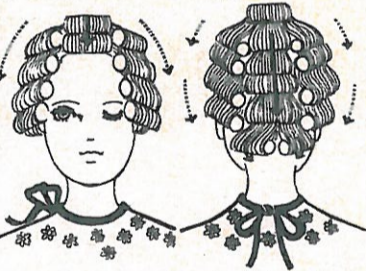
The feathery fluffs (pages 90, 91) take flight in a soft sweep or a swing



The cut: Have your hair blunt-cut smooth and sleek, leaving about five inches from the crown down to a fringe of bangs (let them barely brush your eyebrows). The sides should be tapered gently to meet the back, which is about seven inches long.

The set: Wind your locks around medium-size electric rollers to give them the softest set—and the speediest too. Turning all the rollers under, follow this pattern: set two forward at the crown, four down each side, four down mid-back with four at each side of those. Wind two more rollers at the nape of the neck, or if your hair is too will-o-the-wispy, make tiny pincurls and tack them in place with hair-setting tape.

The comb-out: Brush, brush, brush, with a quick flick of the wrist, till your soft fluff of hair absolutely gleams. Glide locks into place by guiding them sideways; shake your set and you're all set. This hairdo doesn't need a tease to be pretty as you please.



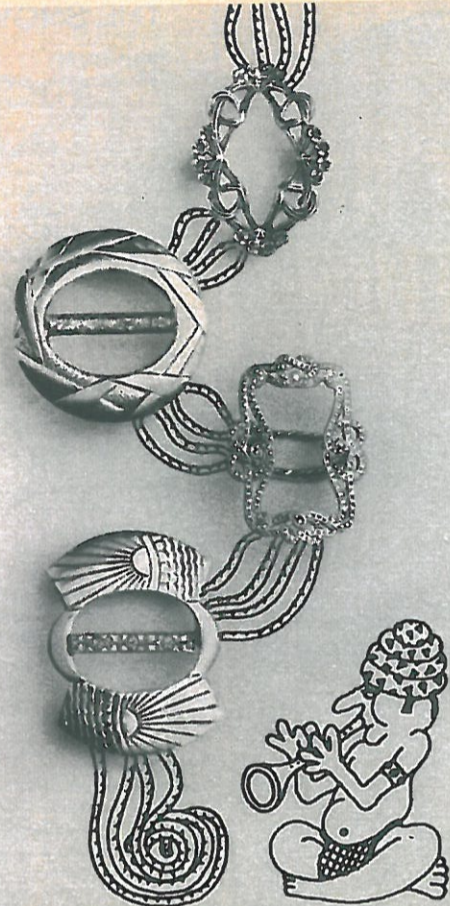
The cut: Shear magic does it again, but this time the blunt cut makes waves for the longer-haired lass. Bangs stay at five inches (skimming eyebrow tops), sides and back are gradually tapered till your hair is a straight-capped helmet. Length may be graduated to as long as eight or nine inches from the crown.

The set: After shampooing, apply a conditioner-setting lotion combination. Then make a center part, section hair and set in jumbo pincurls all around the edges. Let hair dry completely.

Loosen a curl at a time and wrap around a warm curling iron. Hold it in place till the curl takes. Don't let the iron get too hot.

The comb-out (essentially a brush-out): As you brush the crown sleek-down, flick up the ends with quick little strokes.

Hair will have enough body to keep the fluff puffed, and the fringe along your forehead will go anywhere you and your brush swing or swirl it. Spray on a soft-hold mist.
