



Ride High in Snow-going Slicks

Skimming the snowfields in racy Ski-Doos calls for getups with "break-out" (that's snowmobile lingo for being the front runner, pulling ahead to leave all "turtles" behind). Our slicksuits have it, with blink-bright nylon shined to a high gloss and underlined with a generous fluff of fiberfill.
