



Go Glowy in Sun-shined Scarlet

The red suits are coming—and they're going swimming in snow country! The pool is so tempting (it's almost tub temperature), and there's nothing like a good, glowy sunbath and soak to soothe your ski-tight muscles. Sun-spangled ciré, on opposite page, all shined and shimmered and knit to a dewdrop glisten—and that's *before* you take a dip!

Camisole cover-up, left, skims your swimwear with a tanky streak, slick as lipstick! About \$13. Slippery wetsuit, right, is a languid pour that skinnies on with just a hint of shaping to the bra. About \$25. Both by Villager.

Velour joins the swim, this page, and drenches you with softness.

Strike matches in fire-engine red lit with strokes of lightning. Gold-banded scoop top, left (about \$18), glides modestly over glossy wide-legged flares (about \$16).

Mini bikini, right (for a maxi-tan plan), is—briefly—a suit of the same smooth-going panne velour knit. About \$16. Jacket is a fiery breeze-breaker that sends a sunny zip up to the blazing collar; cuffs button up more coziness. About \$14. All panne velour plush-knits are by Dune Deck
